

WARD STREET CORRIDOR IMPROVEMENT STUDY

STUDY APPROACH

The overall study is seen to have four components:

- To develop a broad overview of improvements to the present and future Bridgenorth road network. It's intent will be to assure that any improvements to the Ward Street corridor will allow/support/protect options for future development of the community road network.
- To complete a detailed Ward Street corridor study based on current and medium term future traffic demands. The planning horizon for the study will be co-ordinated with the opening of the Bridgenorth By-pass.
- To complete detailed traffic analysis of the corridor to identify specific locations with capacity shortfalls as well as deficiencies in the overall operation of the corridor.
- To develop a detailed plan for Ward Street improvements. The plan will be phased to be implemented over a planning and development period that is consistent with County planning and capital budgeting programs.
- To complete a parking study to assure present parking impacted by Ward Street improvements is accommodated in appropriate locations.
- To develop a plan for pedestrian/bike-way access to support non-auto travel along the Ward Street corridor.
