**For the Paving of
County Road 29
(Queen Street/Bridge Street)**

The County of Peterborough is undertaking the Paving of County Road 29 through the Village of Lakefield. The location of the project will be at the westerly limit of Lakefield (Maples Restaurant) to the entrance of Lakefield College, at the east limit of Lakefield.

This project will commence at the end of July 2010 and be implemented in three (3) stages.

1. The first stage consists of pulverizing and paving 1.0 km; starting at the westerly limit (Maples Restaurant) to Lakefield High School.
2. The second stage consists of removing the existing asphalt and repaving from Lakefield High School to Strickland Street. Stage two will not commence until September 7th, 2010, however curb and road spot repairs will begin July 2010 in all areas.
3. The third stage consists of removing existing asphalt and repaving from Strickland Street to the entrance of Lakefield College.

A Public Information Centre is being held to provide information.
