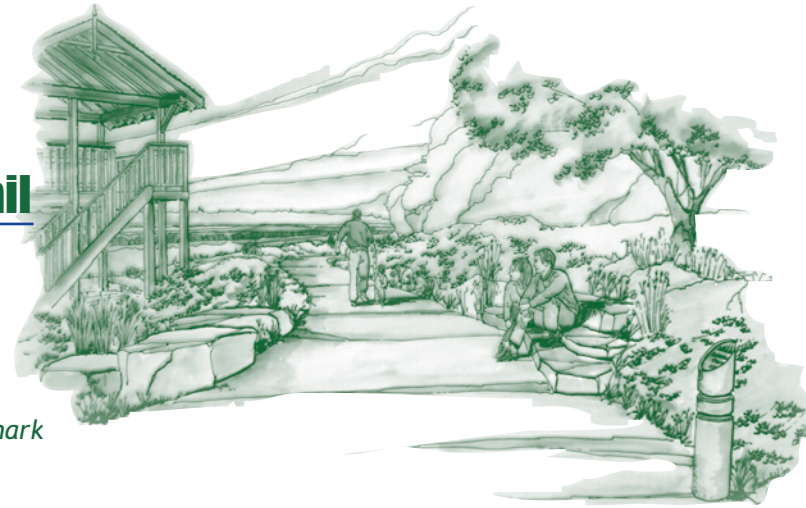

A new scenic Trail network meanders past river, field and forest to enhance the setting of our village. The 5.5 km. trail connects along the Otonabee River via the Peterborough County Rotary Trail, to the Trans Canada Trail.

land from the Imagine the Marsh

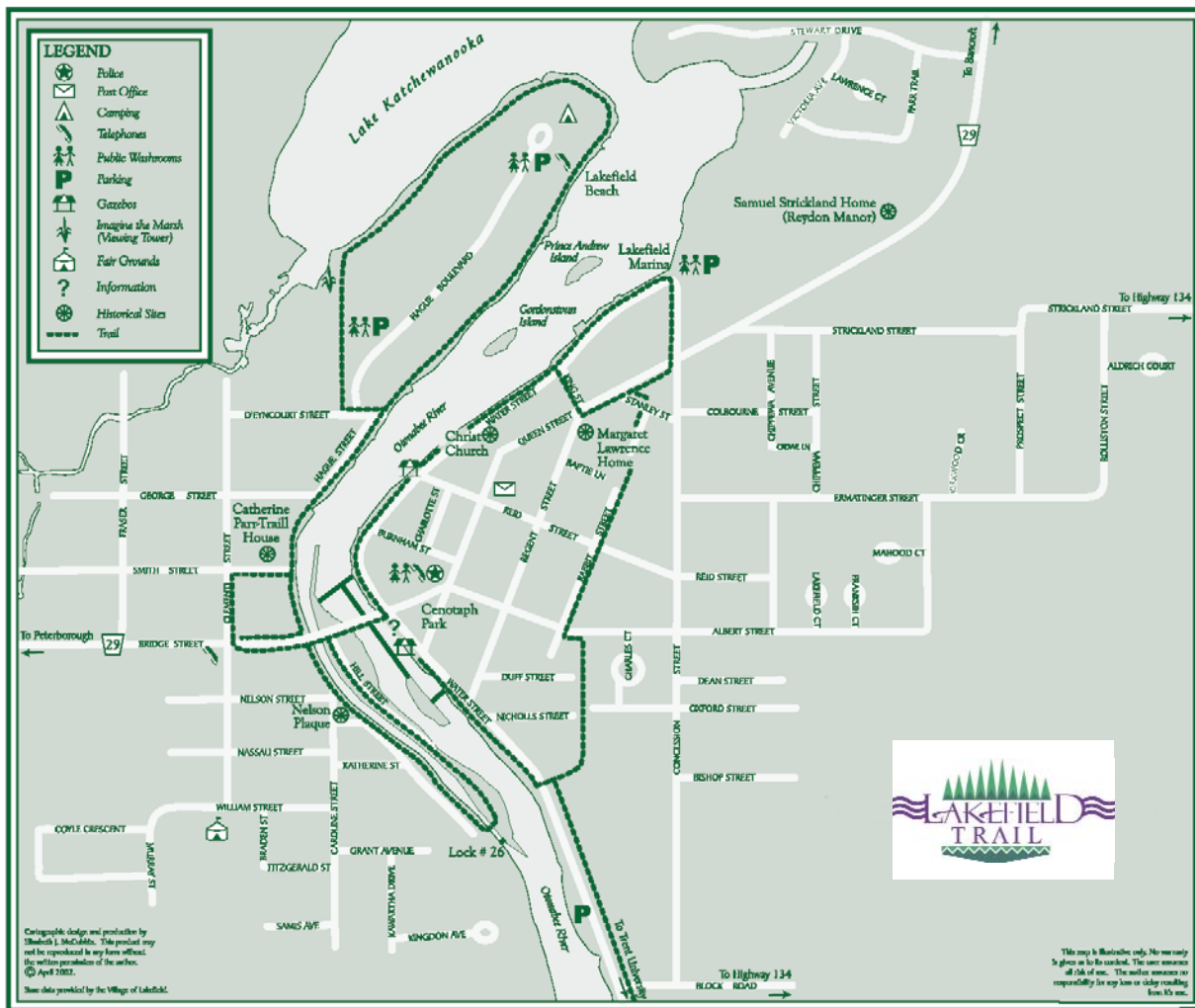
viewing tower. To appreciate
